



Cairo, Fayoum, Bahariya Oasis, Farafra Oasis, Dakhla Oasis & Luxor

Day/01: Cairo

Arrival at Cairo airport, meeting with our tour manager, who will help you through your immigration and customs formalities, then he will escort you to your hotel for check in and overnight.

Day/02: Cairo

Breakfast at hotel. You will meet with your guide at the lobby to tour some of Egypt's most ancient sites : the ruins of Memphis at the edge of the western desert, Egypt's first Capital until the end of the Kingdom and one of the most important cities throughout the history of Ancient Egypt. Close to Memphis, we drive to Sakkara, the City of the dead with the famous step

Pyramid of Djoser. Continue your tour the Pyramids of Giza, The Great Pyramid Cheops (Khufu's), is the largest one of the

three and one of the Seven Wonders of the ancient world, was built In the 4th dynasty about 2690 B.C. In front of the Pyramid

of Chephren, there stand the alabaster Sphinx, which was discovered in 1912, carved from a single piece of stone. It is a lion

with a Pharaoh's head thought to be a portrait of the Pharaoh Chephren. Back to your hotel for overnight.(B)

Day/03: Fayoum

Breakfast at hotel , Meeting with your guid to start your trip to the nature reserve Wadi Rayan,

south of Fayum, a desert habitat that is home to gazelles and rare foxes. Then move on to Wadi Hitan (Valley of the Whales), which is a site rich in fossils, especially of marine creatures, and is known for its fiery red sunsets. Overnight in Fayum. (B)

Day/04: Bahariya Oasis

Breakfast at hotel . Drive to Bahariya Oasis. Enjoy a tour around the old village of the oasis and see the groves of palms and fruit trees. Then take a trip to the Black Mountains, the sand dunes and the salt lake. Visit the ruin on a hill, 'the English House' at sunset and enjoy the panoramic view. In the evening, visit the village and shops. Overnight at hotel in Bahariya. (B, L, D)

Day/05: Bahariya Oasis

Breakfast at hotel. Start your trip by 4x4 Jeep Safari to the White Desert, passing through the Black Desert and the Valley of El Haize with its hot spring. Stop off to see the quartz crystal at Crystal Mountain and the volcanic rocks in the Valley of Agabat. Camp in the mystical silence of the White Desert, watching the myriad of stars. Dinner with Bedouin entertainment. (B, L, D)

Day/06: Farafra Oasis

Breakfast . Drive to Farafra Oasis and enjoy a tour around this oasis to see the palm groves and hot springs as well as the old village with its traditional mud-brick houses, and local artist Badr's unique mudbrick museum. Move to the lush Dakhla Oasis surrounded by rose-colored cliffs. Overnight at hotel in Dakhla. (B, L, D)

Day/07: Dakhla Oasis

Breakfast at hotel. Visits around Dakhla Oasis, the last place in Egypt, where the water wheels, driven by buffaloes are constructed. Visit the Roman temple Deir El Hagar in its serene surroundings and the Roman burial ground Mezzawaqqah. Drive to Kharga Oasis, also famous for its hot springs. Visit Qasr El Labeka, a Roman fortress on the old caravan route. Overnight at hotel in Kharga. (B, L, D)

Day/08: Luxor

Breakfast at hotel. You will visit the Oasis' Ethnic Museum. Then visit the Roman Temple of Hibis, as well as the early Christian cemetery with its chapels painted with murals at Bagawat, nearby. Drive to Luxor and overnight at hotel in Luxor. (B)

Day/09: Luxor

Breakfast at hotel. Cross to the West Bank visit the Valley of the Kings and Queens, where tombs of 64 Pharaohs and 57 Queens have been discovered, the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut at Deir El Bahari and the Colossi of Memnon facing the Nile. Continue your tour Visiting the Karnak Temple, one of the greatest architectural achievements of antiquity. It is a vast complex that embodies the works of many Pharaohs added over the centuries. It was the most important sanctuary in Ancient Egypt then visit the Temple of Luxor, which was started by Amenhotep III and completed by Ramses II. Rest of the Day at leisure for your enjoyment on your own. Later Meeting with your local tour manager in Luxor to transfer you to Luxor station for your sleeper train back to Cairo Dinner and overnight on board train. (B, D)

Day/10: Cairo

Breakfast on board train. Upon arrival at Cairo station you will be transferred to your hotel for check in and freshen up. Then meeting with your tour guide at the lobby to enjoy your tour visiting one of the famous and unique museums the World. The Egyptian Museum, famous for its antiquities from Egypt's Pharaonic period, which includes the fabulous treasures of King Tut-Ankh-Amon. Continue your tour to Old Cairo visiting the oldest part of Cairo to St. Sergious Church, where the Holy Family was hidden while they were in Egypt. Followed by visiting the oldest Jewish Synagogue of Ben Ezra. Visit the medieval Citadel of Salah El- Din, which contains many structures, the most impressive of which is the Alabaster Mosque of Mohamed Ali, It was designed in the early 19th Century by a Greek Architect from Turkey. At the end of your tour visit Khan El Khalili Bazaar, the Old market. Return back to your hotel for overnight. (B)

Day/11: Cairo

Breakfast at hotel. Meeting with your tour manager to transfer you to Cairo airport and helped through your check-in and immigration formalities for your international flight back home. (B)
